Requests the Submission of Expressions of Interest (EOI) from Suitably Qualified and Experienced Parties wanting to participate in the Work Package below.

Package Description: Kabanga Site Lubrication Storage

Tembo Nickel Corporation ("Tembo") is an operational company established through the Framework Agreement (19 January 2021) between Kabanga Nickel Limited ("Kabanga Nickel") and the Government of Tanzania ("GoT") for the development of the Kabanga Nickel Deposits in the Ngara District in North-West Tanzania. Under the terms of the Framework Agreement, Tembo (owned 84% by Kabanga Nickel and 16% by GoT) has been officially formed for the mining, processing, and potential future beneficiation of nickel, copper and cobalt.

The Project is a fully integrated, greenfield development that will produce nickel, copper, and cobalt products for the global market. As one of the world's largest undeveloped high-grade nickel sulfide deposits, the Project represents a globally significant opportunity aligned with the accelerating transition to a low-carbon economy and is positioned to deliver both strategic value to the global supply chain and meaningful economic and social benefits to Tanzania and its citizens. The Kabanga Mine, Concentrator, and associated infrastructure are situated at the Kabanga Site, where nickel sulfide concentrate will be produced.

1. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF SERVICES

The service provider shall supply and deliver bulk lubrication via road tankers, 1000L IBCs or 208L drums to the Kabanga Site. Additional to the supply of lubrication, the service provider will also provide storage and dispensing infrastructure on Site with a 14-day holding capacity. The storage infrastructure will include:

- Self-bunded storage tanks with minimum capacity of 2,250L for engine oil, hydraulic oil, transmission oil and coolant
- Self-bunded storage tank with minimum capacity of 10,000L for waste oil
- Double diaphragm decanting and dispensing pumps engine oil, hydraulic oil, transmission oil and coolant
- All interconnecting piping, hosing and valves
- All instrumentation and safety devices
- Hose reel stations for HME workshop with double diaphragm pumps for waste oil

The service provider is required to:

- Maintain and calibrate all pumps, filters and meters at least once every three months;
- Attend to emergency breakdowns of lubrication pumps within 4 hours of a call;
- Liaise with Tembo Nickel if any repairs and maintenance works is to be carried out on the lubrication system;
- Submit on a quarterly basis, maintenance and service reports on the lubrication pumps;
- **Check and verify the quality of the lubrication oil in the storage tanks to see if there is a concern of contamination**

2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Companies wishing to be considered for inclusion in the **Kabanga Site Lubrication Storage** Tender Process are invited to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) on their official company letterhead. The EOI must be accompanied by the following minimum information and supporting documentation:

2.1 Commercial Documents:

- Full company profile.
- Company code of conduct.
- Certificate of ethics.
- Certified copy of Registration/incorporation certificate.
- Certified copy of a Valid Tax Clearance.
- Certified copy of Memorandum and Articles of Association.
- Certified copy of Business License/Sectorial Permit.
- Certified copy of Tanzanian Tax Identification Number (TIN) and VAT Registration Number (VRN) Certificate OR Certified copy of Company Tax certification.
- Certified copy of the current Business Registrations and Licensing Agency (BRELA) Standard Search
- Company Shareholding Structure (ownership of shares in %), where applicable.
- Certificates and Passport/Voter or National ID card, where applicable.
- Management and Local Company definition
- Mining Local Content Compliance Documents, preferably an approved Mining Local Content Plan

2.2 Experience and Capability Submissions:

- An overview of the Company's recent service history with clients and projects of a comparable scale, nature, and location. The submission should demonstrate proven capability and experience in providing lubrication supply, storage and dispensing services.
- Details of workload projection for the next six to twelve months, in terms of lubrication supply, storage and dispensing services.
- Brief method statement of how your Company would execute the Services.
- Curriculum Vitae outlining years of service and experience of key personnel to be assigned.

2.3 Financial Position and Terms of Trade:

- Financial Capacity to complete the services required, including submissions of Audited and Certified Financial Statements (2023-2025).
- At least one reference from the Company's banker regarding their credit position.
- Proposed pathways or alternative financing arrangements that could provide measurable financial or scheduling benefits to the Employer.

2.4 Safety, Environmental and Quality Management Systems:

- Provide a valid Tanzanian Occupational Safety and Health Authority (OSHA) Certificate of Compliance (Occupational Health and Safety Act of 2003).
